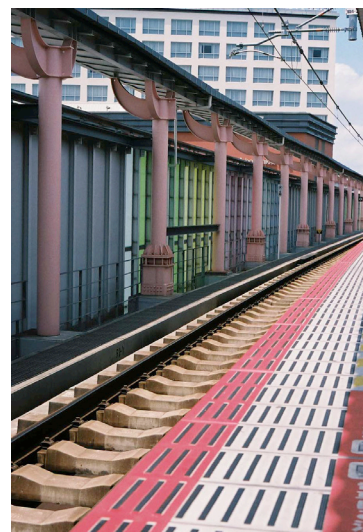

This annual event celebrates the latest developments in lens-based arts practice from around the country, and provides an exciting opportunity to exhibit work in a professional, high-profile context. Supported by 21 national leaders in the photographic industry, *CCP Salon* awards up to \$20,000 across 26 prize categories. The major prize is awarded by Leica and Ilford for Excellence in Photomedia, other prize categories include the Pat Corrigan AM Acquisitive Award, Best Use of Natural Light, Best Use of Digital Media, Best Architectural Work, Excellence in Colour, Best Fashion Work, Best Portrait, Best Black and White Work and for the first time in *CCP Salon* history you can enter a self-published photobook! Visitors are also invited to vote for their favourite image in the Michaels People's Choice Award.

Salon entries are OPEN and will remain open until 6pm Friday 4 November 2016!
